THREE-DAY ACCULTURATION PROGRAMME HOSTED IN GARDEN CITY UNIVERSITY CAMPUS



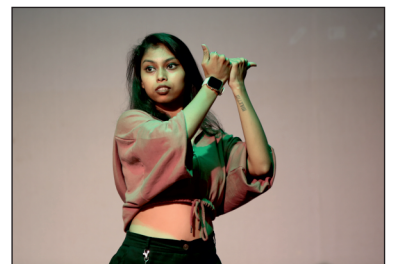

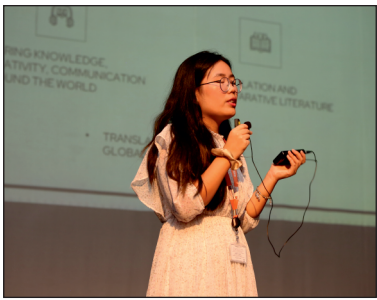

SCHOOL OF HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT SKILL SHOW

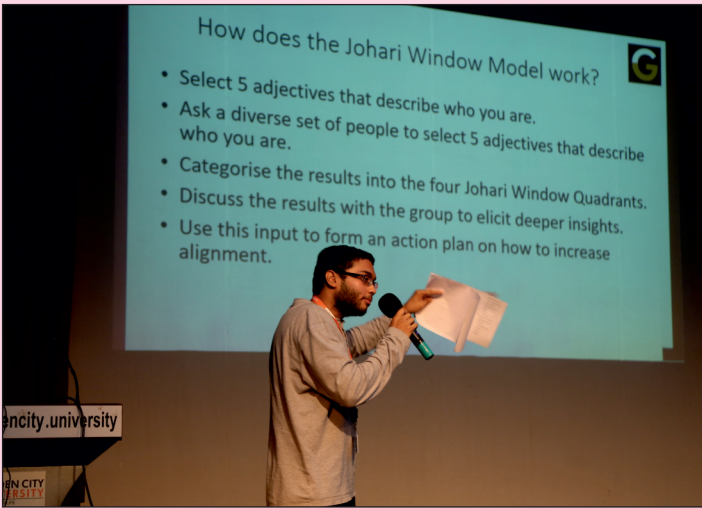
