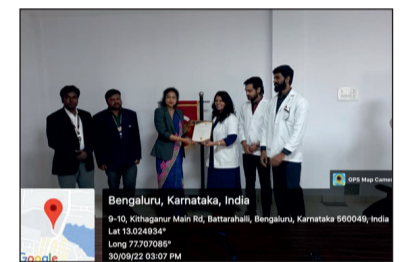
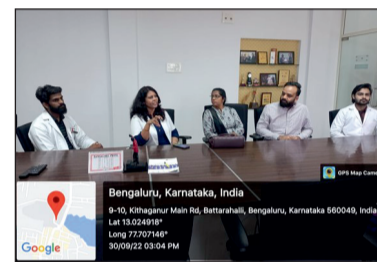
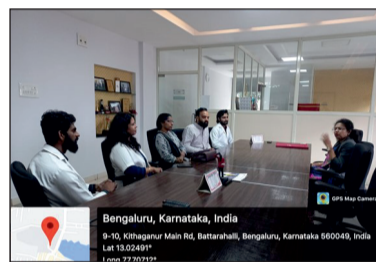
GCU TRAVEL DESK ORGANIZES TREKKING TRIP TO MAKALIDURGA FORT

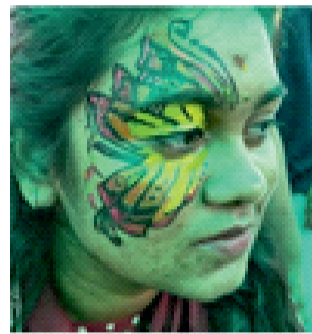
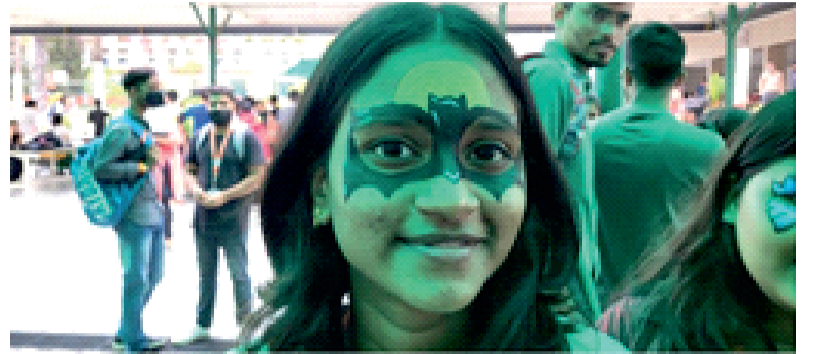
